Holy Communion Programme

Our theme is still 'Being Sorry'. Last week, we talked to the children about reconciliation and what it means to God, ourselves and others. We also had their Enrolment Mass where we introduced them all to the Parish. They put candles on the map of the world sending love and light to that country. We have also placed their prayers in the fishing net display at the front of the altar. If you would like to add your own prayers, please leave them in front of the net and we will add them to the display.

Confirmation 2022

We will be Confirming our young people at the 6.30pm Mass on Saturday 4th June 2022 - Pentecost weekend. Any young people (or not so young) of school Year 8 and above are most welcome to join us. We will need to see a CATHOLIC Baptism Certificate along with proof of receiving 1st Holy Communion. Details of the course and registration will be available throughout December after 10.15am Mass or contact Father Seba for a registration form. Dates of the programme will be available soon. The first session will be on Wednesday 12th January 2022 in the parish hall at 7.00 for Confirmandi only. It is vitally important that all the programme is completed. The sessions will not be every week so there will be plenty of time to fit it in between exams and school work. As normal, we are asking people for help to enable us to provide this programme. Pray in front of the Blessed Sacrament and listen to see if the Lord is calling you for help, if so please contact Mary 07985 360960 or Fr Seba. Whilst recognising the important of parents and relations on a young person faith journey it is not suitable for them to be engaged as catechists in the programme. Their role is to journey with their young people and to continue their calling as the first educators of the faith. There will be 4 sessions for parents/guardians during the programme.

Saint of the day

Saint Anrê Tran Van Trông



There were 117 Catholics martyred in Vietnam from the years of 1625-1886. They were either flogged, crucified, beheaded, or starved and in the 1886 they were shot to death. There were many of brothers sisters that were killed for loving the Virgin Mary, Christ and adoring the Blessed Sacrament. Anrê Tran Van Trông was raised Catholic, but he kept quiet about it in public. Lifelong layman, career soldier and officer, he worked help the missionaries of the Paris Foreign Mission In 1834 Society. authorities discovered Anrê's Catholicism; he was stripped of rank and imprisoned for his faith. He was given the opportunity to gain his freedom by renouncing Christianity; he declined. One of the
